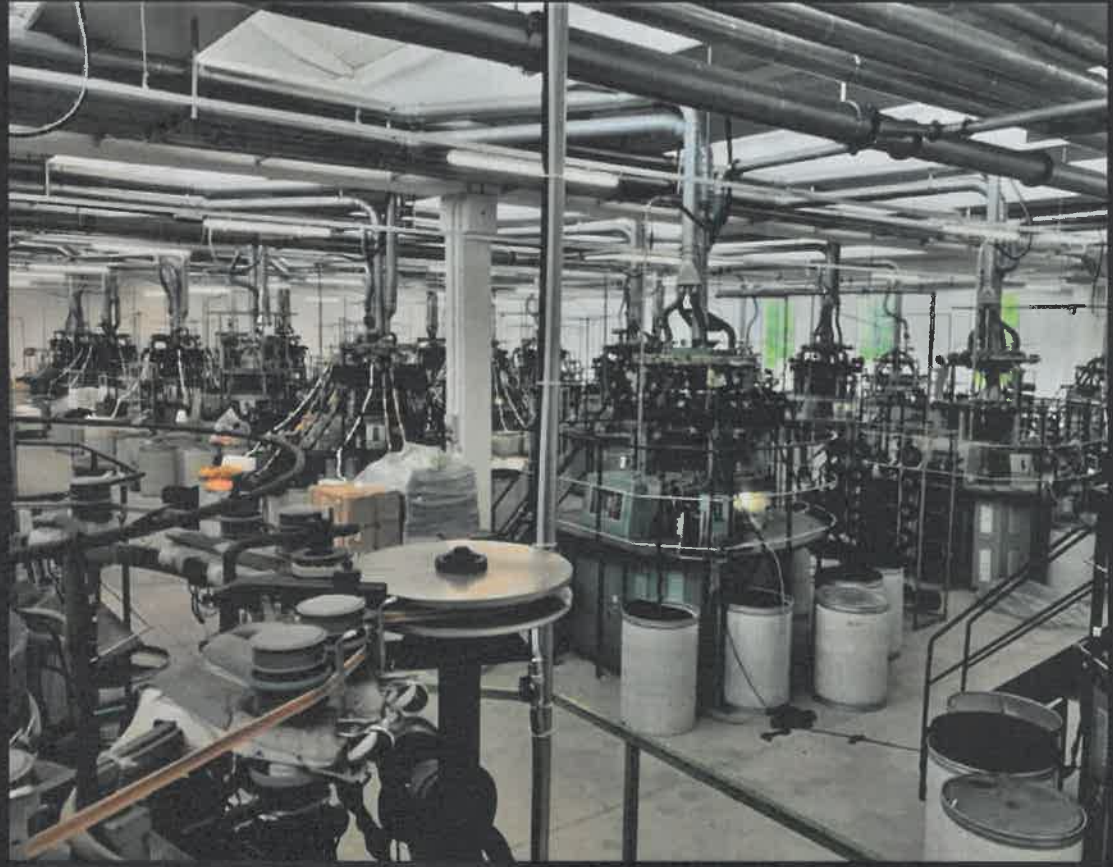

In the early nineties, he modified his equipment of textile circular machines with the innovative technology of recaptured fibre, called “loop”. Such a technology was conceived and developed inside the factory.

By that way, Texapel has become, throughout the years, a world leader in an innovative textile technology, particularly appreciated around the world by garment manufacturers and not only.

Over the years, the equipment has been continuously updated in quality and quantity until the current significant number of 40 circular machines. Starting from 2020, the equipment will be implemented by new electronics and control systems. The structure and the number of machines in the knitting department allows high production capacity in a short time.

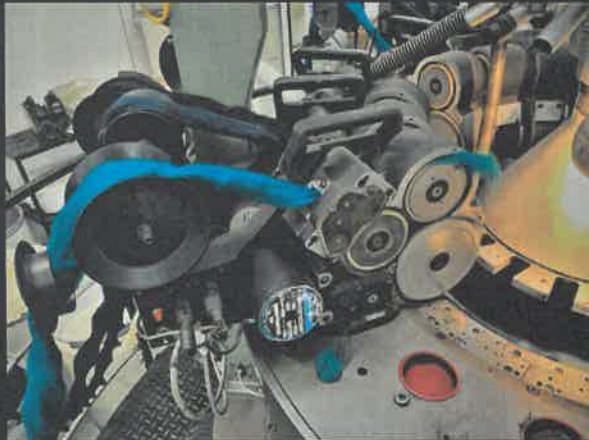
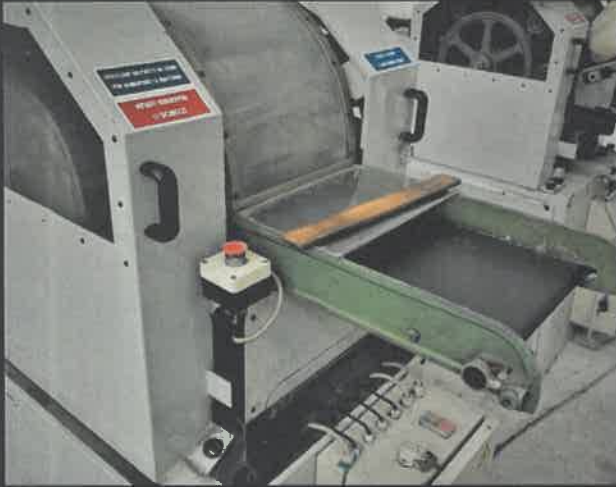
- Raw materials

The company directly imports raw materials from the countries of origin: wool taken from New Zealand, together with other precious fibres such as Alpaca Mohair from South America, cashmere, silk, camel hair and others. All the supply respect the international standards both for recycled GRS requirements and the natural fibres sustainability such as RWS.

All raw materials are being treated in terms of dyeing, carding, knitting and finishing directly from our company and its partners; therefore, the whole productive process is entirely monitored by internal control procedures, throughout the help of the technicians.

The result of such choices are products of the highest quality which can substitute the real traditional animal furs using animal fibers instead. These last ones are obtained by a seasonal shearing of the animals, without causing them any violence, instead safeguarding and maintaining them in their natural habitat.
